Policies on Performance Dress Code, Concert Etiquette, & Rehearsal Etiquette

DRESS CODE

In keeping with the Ensemble's many years of elegant tradition, the following Dress Code applies to all concert performers:

GIRLS: Long dress pants, dressy skirt, or dress – at least knee length for skirt or dress.

BOYS: Long dress pants with dress shirt and tie; suit or sports jacket; or nice sweater.

GIRLS & BOYS: No sport shoes, no jeans.

CONCERT ETIQUETTE

We believe that music enriches the soul. We believe that putting music in the hearts of children will make them better human beings. We hope this concert will express the finer aspects of the human experience. To that end, we ask all concert participants and audience members to:

Refrain from using cell phones or electronic devices

Remain in your seats during the performance

Stay and hear the entire concert, leaving early is rude to the other performers

REHEARSAL ETIQUETTE

- Come with clean hands
- Be **early** to rehearsals to hear announcements
- No chewing gum
- Be prepared and ready to work
- **Bring your music to every rehearsal**, take notes as directed
- Be attentive to the conductor and teachers
- No playing when the conductor is talking
- Be respectful of your partner and those around you
